Which metering course is right for you?

Choosing the right metering course depends on the type of work you intend to carry out. Metering generally falls into two main categories:

1. Installing meters for a metering provider

For electricians installing or replacing meters on behalf of a metering provider as part of a bulk meter rollout.

2. Level 2 ASP Metering

For electricians carrying out metering and service work on customer installations, including switchboards and service equipment, typically through a Level 2 ASP accredited business.

Both pathways require authorisation from the relevant **meter provider** for any meter that is installed, removed, relocated, or replaced.

For ASP metering work, you must also meet the requirements of the relevant **network operator**, such as Ausgrid, Endeavour Energy, or Essential Energy.

Which pathway applies to you?

Installing meters for a metering provider only?

(Bulk meter rollout work paid by the meter provider or primary contractor)

You will generally require one of the following training packages:

or

[Install and commission electricity meters & Testing of Connections \(Package\)](#)

Some metering providers also require UETDRMP011 – Testing of Connections to low voltage electricity networks. Please confirm this with your metering provider before booking so we can ensure you complete the correct units.

Some metering providers also require 11084NAT Asbestos Awareness

Asbestos Awareness Requirement (Some Providers)

Some metering providers require **11084NAT – Asbestos Awareness**.

This can be completed externally via providers such as ALERTforce:

alertforce.com.au (Filter search to Asbestos Awareness). They run regular webinar courses which can be booked online.

(Metering and service work for customers, builders, or contractors – including relocations and load control)

You will require our **[Level 2 ASP Pathway \(Metering\)](#)** course.

Installing meters for a metering provider

These packages cover the skills and knowledge required to:

- Install, configure, and commission electricity meters
- Work safely in accordance with workplace procedures and AS/NZS 3000
- Test and verify meter wiring and MEN systems
- Perform safe isolation and restoration of electrical supply
- Identify hazards and apply risk control measures
- Complete metering documentation and compliance requirements

This training provides the required foundation for undertaking smart metering work, **subject to approval by the relevant meter provider.**

Level 2 ASP Pathway (Metering)

This course covers the skills required to install and replace energy meters and associated equipment within the electricity supply industry.

It includes:

- Installing, replacing, testing, and commissioning meters
- Working on service equipment and switchboards
- De-energising and re-energising electrical installations
- Installing and modifying load control equipment (e.g. ripple control, time clocks)
- Relocating service equipment and panels
- Identifying and managing electrical risks

This package supports the training requirements for those seeking to work under, or progress toward, Level 2 ASP metering activities.
